



## **COMSTOCK ARABIAN HORSE ASSOCIATION OUTSTANDING YOUTH APPLICATION DIRECTIONS**

**GOAL:** To recognize Comstock Arabian Horse Association youth members for good citizenship, achievement with academics, activities with their club and activity with their Arabian/Half-Arabian/Anglo-Arabian horses.

### **RULES:**

- ❖ There will be two age levels eligible for participation; Junior Youth - 13 & under and Senior youth - 14 to 18 years of age. The age of the youth on January 1 of the year will be the age of consideration for the year.
- ❖ \*Awards will be presented to both age groups
- ❖ \*Participation in a minimum of 4 Comstock Arabian Association youth activities are required. These include meetings and or events.
- ❖ \*All awards will be based on a merit point system maintained by the youth. The youths with the highest number of points will be the winners
- ❖ \*A maximum number of 200 points can be accumulated in each of the three categories of academics, citizenship and horse activities.
- ❖ \*Points will be accumulated from November 1<sup>st</sup> to October 31<sup>st</sup> for citizenship and horse activities.
- ❖ \*Academics will be based on the school year from August to August.
- ❖ \*Application, maintenance of points and documentations of proof is the responsibility of the youth and to be done by the youth for the award.
- ❖ \*The completed application with all points tabulated and documentations of proof must be submitted to a member of the CAA Board of Directors or mailed to the P.O. Box 21155, Reno, NV 89515 by October 31<sup>st</sup>.
- ❖ \*All applications and points will be verified by CAA Application Committee.
- ❖ \*Winners of the Outstanding Youth Awards for Junior and Senior division will be announced at the annual CAA awards dinner in January
- ❖ \*Please print out AHA Results for AHA Sanctioned Show. All other Show/Events need to be signed by show secretary.

### **AWARDS:**

- ❖ Junior Youth-CAA jacket with award and name on it and \$200.
- ❖ Senior Youth-CAA jacket with award and name on it and \$300

## POINT SYSTEM:

- ❖ Citizenship, academics, and horse activities will each count 200 points maximum accrual from each category.
- ❖ A horse related talk of at least 5 minutes duration presented to the CAA Board of Directors will be worth 50 points
- ❖ Citizenship-Any activity by the youth that brings benefit to others. Examples
- ❖ Include charitable fund raising, helping in soup kitchens, Ice cream social to benefit CAA, tutoring, giving clinics or talks, volunteering for religious events and recognition of citizenship on report cards. These are but a few.
- ❖ Contact CAA youth director to ascertain your activity qualifies.
- ❖ Proof of participation needed; document signed by teacher, youth director, committee chairman etc. Parents only sign for rail riders or if organizer of activity.
- ❖ Tiebreak test – 20 questions based on horses will be given to break a point related tie after the October 31<sup>st</sup> deadline.

### Academics – Copy of report card required and signature of teacher or adult leader for extracurricular activities. Use semester or quarter grades Copy of report card needed for grades and signed document by teacher or adult leader for extracurricular activity.

### Horse Activities - Copy of official show results needed to confirm competition results. Show management signature for smaller shows as in Sagebrush or 4 – H if no official results are available. Parent signature for recreational trail rides, trainer signature for lessons, equine clinics, endurance rides and judging need manager signature. Include official show results print out.

- ❖ 1<sup>st</sup> 1 point for each entry in class
- ❖ 2<sup>nd</sup> 1 point each entry minus 1
- ❖ 3<sup>rd</sup> 1 point each entry minus 2
- ❖ 4<sup>th</sup> 1 point each entry minus 3
- ❖ 5<sup>th</sup> 1 point each entry minus 4
- ❖ 6<sup>th</sup> 1 point each entry minus 5
- ❖ 7<sup>th</sup> 1 point each entry minus 6
- ❖ 8<sup>th</sup> 1 point each entry minus 7
- ❖ 9<sup>th</sup> 1 point each entry minus 8
- ❖ 10<sup>th</sup> 1 point each entry minus 9
- ❖ Championship 5 points plus 1 point each entry
- ❖ Res. Champ 3 points plus 1 point each entry
- ❖ Top 5 Regional Show 7 points
- ❖ Top 10 National Show 10 points

- ❖ Red Ribbon 2 points
- ❖ White Ribbon 1 point
