ATTENTION DRESSAGE AND WESTERN DRESSAGE EXHIBITORS IMPORTANT INFORMATION

All Dressage classes are open to Arabian, Half Arabian and Anglo Arabian horses. Western Dressage classes are open to Arabian, Half Arabian and Anglo Arabian horses **as well as other breeds**. Current tests will be ridden. Training devices will not be allowed in the designated dressage area at any time or in any other warm-up areas when warming up for Dressage. The designated Dressage warm-up area will be the Center/Warm-Up Arena. Dressage exhibitors must wear their entry number at all times on the show grounds when warming up for Dressage. All Dressage and Western Dressage classes will be held in the MAIN Arena.

THESE RULES WILL BE ENFORCED AT ALL TIMES ON THURSDAY AND FRIDAY.



USEF Membership Statement

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$45 Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR218) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

GR1301.7 Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense.

GR1301.8 Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

Important information for all exhibitors

USEF Rule GR801.7: Helmets are encouraged for all riders as noted in the following USEF rule

Except as may otherwise be mandated by local law, the Federation strongly encourages all riders, while riding anywhere on the competition grounds, to wear protective headgear with harness secured which passes or surpasses ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. (Exception hunter, jumper, or hunter/jumper competitions refer to GR801.2) It is the responsibility of the rider, or the parent or guardian or trainer of the junior exhibitor to see to it that the headgear worn complies with appropriate safety standards for protective headgear intended for equestrian use, and is properly fitted and in good condition, and the Federation, Show Committee, Competition Management, and Licensed Officials are not responsible for checking headgear worn for such compliance.

USEF Rule EQ105.1: Helmets are required for all hunter seat equitation riders as noted in the following USEF rule

Protective headgear. All riders must wear protective headgear (USEF rule EQ105).

Important information for all Dressage exhibitors

USEF Rule DR120.6: Helmets are required for all riders as noted in the following USEF rule

From the time horses are officially admitted to the competition grounds by competition management, anyone mounted on a horse at any time on the competition grounds, including non-competing riders, riders on non-

exhibition classes and those competing in all classes and tests, including Para-Equestrian tests, must wear protective headgear as defined by this rule and otherwise in compliance with GR801. Any rider violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding until such headgear is properly in place. Protective headgear is defined as a riding helmet which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. The harness must be secured and properly fitted.

Attention Dressage Riders:

Make it a three day adventure - Show at Čomstock on Friday, then head up to Ironwood Equestrian Center for two more days of Dressage competition Saturday and Sunday sponsored by Sierra Nevada Chapter. This show is recognized by SNC for their Year End Awards. Check it out at snc-cds.org.

- 1. Entries MUST be submitted on the Official Entry Form for this Show. No entries will be taken over the telephone. If additional entry forms are required, photocopy BOTH SIDES of the entry form.
- 2. Complete NAME and ADDRESS of the Registered Owner Must appear in the space for Owner Information ONE OWNER ONLY per form.
- A copy of the REGISTATION PAPERS (FRONT AND BACK) OF EACH HORSE showing proof of ownership must be submitted with entry form at the time of making entry. In case of a sale or lease, it is required that a contract of sale or lease, or statement from the owner be submitted with the copy of registration papers. (Exception: Horses under one year of age that are eligible for registry or registration applied for.)
- 4. HORSES ENTERED IN AMATEUR OWNER AND JUNIOR CLASSES MUST BE REGISTERED IN THE NAME OF THE COMPETITOR OR MEMBER OF THE COMPETITOR'S FAMILY (as defined in USEF GR123, Page GR7). If showing as an Amateur, member to insert your relationship to the owner on the entry form. CONTRACT OF SALE OR BILL OF SALE WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. The sale of a horse does not eliminate this registration requirement. (Horses registered in a farm/ranch/syndicate/partnership/corporation name may be shown in Amateur Owner classes provided all owners are members of the same family.)
- 5. EVERY ÓWNER, EXHIBITOR, TRAINER, COACH, RIDER/DRIVER/BREEDING HALTER HANDLER or his/her agents MUST SIGN the entry blank. In case of a rider/driver/handler under 18, his/her parent or guardian, or if not available, the trainer must sign the entry blank on the minor's behalf. A minor cannot sign for him/herself. (Trainer is "any adult who has the responsibility for the care, training, custody or performance of a horse"). Junior Owners are not eligible to sign as trainer Adult MUST sign as Trainer. If the Owner has no trainer, owner must sign in trainer sections also.
- 6. Include COPIES of CURRENT AHA COMPETITION LEVEL MEMBERSHIP CARDS FOR EVERY TRAINER, RIDER, HANDLER, DRIVER, JUNIOR OWNER & RIDER AND at least ONE CURRENT OWNER. If the above cards are NOT submitted, appropriate fees <u>MUST</u> be paid. If you do not submit a copy of your membership card, you may join the Comstock Arabian Association now or you MUST pay a SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP FEE at \$35 per person. Exception: Junior exhibitors in Academy, Walk-Trot/Jog and Lead line Classes only are exempt from the above requirements. Affidavits are not available.
- 7. Include COPIES of CURRENT USEF MEMBERSHIP CARDS FOR EVERY OWNER, TRAINER, RIDER, HANDLER, DRIVER AND JUNIOR OWNER & RIDER. ADULT RIDER/HANDLER IN AMATEUR OR AMATEUR OWNER CLASSES MUST INCLUDE A COPY OF THEIR USEF AMATEUR CARD. Exhibitors are required to have Amateur Certification. Each competitor is responsible for supplying management with correct USEF numbers for each horse, owner, rider, driver, handler and trainer before the day of competition. The scores of competitors who fail to supply correct numbers may not be counted toward National Awards. However, USDF membership and horse registration are not required to compete in dressage classes at Regular or Local Breed Restricted Competitions. Exemption from this requirement applies to Academy, Walk-Trot/Jog and Lead line riders.
- 8. Include COPIES of CURRENT USDF MEMBERSHIP CARDS FOR EVERY OWNER, TRAINER, COACH, RIDER, HANDLER, DRIVER AND JUNIOR OWNER & RIDER AND HORSE REGISTRATION CARDS if applicable. Each competitor is responsible for supplying management with correct, applicable USDF numbers for each horse, owner, trainer, coach, rider, driver, and handler before the day of competition. The scores of competitors who fail to supply correct numbers may not be counted toward National Awards. Exemption from this requirement applies to Academy, Walk-Trot/Jog and Lead line riders.
- 9. <u>GR845 Equine Vaccination Rule</u> 1. At Federation licensed competitions horses, more than 7 months of age, entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the stables. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the competition grounds upon request by Competition Management. Documentation should consist of one of the following methods mentioned below. The frequency of vaccine administration should be per the vaccine manufacturers' or veterinarian's recommendations. It is recommended that vaccines are administered by or under the direction of a veterinarian. 2. In the case of vaccines administered by a veterinarian, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide documentation from the veterinarian on documenting that the horse in question received the vaccinations; name of the vaccines and date of vaccine administration. 3. In the case of vaccines administered by a person other than a veterinarian, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide a receipt of the vaccine purchase which is signed by the owner, or agent with care, custody, and control of the horse; name, serial number and expiration date of the vaccine; and date of vaccine administration. 4. In the case of a horse that is unable to receive either of the vaccinations due to a history of adverse reactions, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide a letter from the veterinarian on official letterhead stating that the horse in question cannot be vaccinated due to medical concerns and a log of temperatures taken twice daily for the seven days prior to entering the competition grounds. These horses must also have their temperature taken and logged twice daily while on the competition grounds. The log of temperatures should be provided to the Competition Management, steward, or technical delegate when requested. 5. Competition Management
- 10. Enclose a Valid Check or Money Order. ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED OR PROCESSED UNLESS ACCOMPANIED WITH TOTAL AMOUNT DUE FOR ENTRIES. Entries received with partial entry fees WILL be returned to the exhibitor.

Exhibitor is responsible for ensuring that the entry is properly postmarked. Postage meter dates are NOT ACCEPTED; envelope must have an official post office cancellation. Entries are encouraged by April 16, 2021. Dressage and Western Dressage Entries must be postmarked by April 16, 2021.

ACADEMY HORSE CLASSES

All horses must be registered Arabians or Half Arabians/Anglo Arabians that are used as lesson horses or schooling horses in regular riding lesson programs. The coach/instructor of the rider must sign an affidavit confirming the use of the horse entered as a schooling horse. Stallions are prohibited. Rider, of any age, must regularly take riding lessons on the horse entered. Show clothes are optional; schooling clothing including a minimum of long sleeve shirt, riding pants or jeans and belt, riding boots and ASTM/SEI approved equine helmet are required. The safety of all exhibitors must be of primary consideration when conducting the class.

Individuals in this class are exempt from AHA/USEF membership requirements. Academy classes are not USEF recognized.

ACADEMY EQUITATION CLASSES - ARABIAN/HALF ARABIAN/ANGLO ARABIAN

Riders will be judged on seat, hands, performance of horse, and suitability of horse to rider. Results as shown by the performance of the horse are NOT to be considered more important than the method used in obtaining them. No tests shall be call for.

BREEDING/IN-HAND CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES

Breeding/In-Hand Show Champions and Reserve Champions must be at least **one** year old and shall return to the arena for comparative adjudication in the Championship class.

BREEDING/IN-HAND HALTER CLASS PROCEDURES

In all Breeding and Gelding In-Hand halter classes, horses will be judged using the **ARABIAN COMPARATIVE JUDGING SYSTEM** (effective April 1, 2008). The Comstock Arabian Association Spring Fiesta A and the Comstock Arabian Association Spring Fiesta B will use the **IN THE ARENA CLASS ENTRANCE PROCEDURE** for all Breeding/In-Hand halter classes.

CLASS PROCEDURE:

Judging begins when the first horse enters the arena. From the moment the horse enters the arena, its movement is being evaluated. The horse shall enter at a trot, and at the handler's discretion may either proceed directly along the rail or trot a counter-clockwise circle at the in-gate end of the arena and then proceed along the rail to the far end of the arena. Upon each horse reaching the designated position at the far end of the arena, they are to remain relaxed. The judge(s) will then ask for the next horse to enter the arena. When all horses have entered the arena, the horses shall be asked to walk collectively counter-clockwise and/or clockwise past each (and all) judge(s). They shall walk in a relaxed manner on a loose lead with the handler at the side of his/her horse, whips down. The lead line must maintain a discernible drape and the handler must not place his/her hand on the chain or close enough in any way to restrict the natural head and neck motion. The handler may not unnecessarily impede the forward motion of the horse while at the walk. Following the cessation of the walk, all horses shall relax within the arena and only the horse "on deck" shall be prepared to show. Each horse shall be led to the judge(s) at the walk and presented for judging. In order to satisfy a proper presentation to the judge, horses shall walk away from the judge(s), and then strike a trot before turning left and proceeding counter-clockwise down the rail. They shall resume their position on therail.

Handlers are expected to keep a reasonable clearance between horses and judges should modify the alignment of horses to achieve that clearance. Further judging will not commence until the Call Judge approves the placement and spacing of all horses.

After the last horse is presented, judges will have a period of time to finish their evaluation of entries and turn in their card (the specific time period to be determined by Show Management).

In the lineup, horses must stand quietly and may be asked to back individually or as a group. Horse not to stretch in the lineup. **COUNTRY ENGLISH PLEASURE - ARABIAN** Qualifies for Cross entries are prohibited between Arabian Country English Pleasure and Arabian English Pleasure and Pleasure Driving sections and/or Informal Combination classes at the same show. 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USDF Membership Benefits: USDF is dedicated to education, the recognition of achievement, and promotion of dressage. For details on member benefits, including educational programs, awards, and other opportunities, refer to the USDF Member Guide or the USDF website at www.usdf.org. **Membership Requirements for USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized Competitions:** Owners and riders, including foreign riders and owners who are not residents of the US, wishing to participate

and riders, including foreign riders and owners who are not residents of the US, wishing to participate in a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition as a rider or owner/lessee, must have either a USDF Group Membership (GM). Participating Membership (PM), or have a USDF Non-Member (NM) identification of the USDF Non-Member

Group Membership (GM), Participating Membership (PM), or have a USDF Non-Member (NM) identification number and pay the USDF Non-Member (NM) fee. (Note: USDF Business Members can own horses but cannot compete as riders with their USDF Business Membership.) Horses competing at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions must have either a USDF Horse Identification (HID) number or a USDF Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR). Proper credentials or verification certificates must be presented to the competition secretary.

Riders and owners wishing to participate in a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition, and not able to present the competition secretary with verification of a USDF membership or NM identification, and USDF LHR or USDF HID, must complete a USDF Competition Affidavit Form and pay the \$5 affidavit filing fee. A copy of a completed affidavit form from another competition may also be used for verification purposes for up to 60 days. (Exception: Affidavits cannot be used at Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional Dressage Championships.) **Exceptions:**

- Horses competing only in Individual Breed Classes (IBCs) at DSHB competitions, sires and dams of horses in DSHB group classes, where those sires or dams are not actually competing in the same competition, horses competing only in breed restricted dressage or DSHB classes at Regular Competitions (e.g. all Arabian, all Friesian, or all Morgan classes), or in USDF Introductory Level tests, pas de deux or quadrille, are exempt from this requirement. Also exempt are horses ridden in leadline, exhibitions, games and races, classes for 4-H members, walk-trot, academy, and opportunity classes.
- Riders and owners/lessees competing only in classes which are exempt from the USDF HID requirements are also exempt from the USDF NM identification number and NM fee requirements. Also exempt are handlers of horses competing in DSHB In-Hand or Group classes.

Memberships Defined

Participating Membership (PM): A membership issued to an individual directly by USDF. The membership year is December 1 through November 30. PMs are available for 1-year (\$90), 5-years (\$360), or life (\$1,800). A USDF Youth Participating Membership (YPM) is available for individuals who have not reached their 21st birthday by December 1 of the current membership year (\$72). A PM allows the member to compete at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions and to participate as a rider and/or owner/lessee for all Adequan[®]/USDF Year-End Awards and the Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional Dressage Championship program.

Group Membership (GM): A membership issued to an individual by USDF when the member name and dues are submitted to USDF through an affiliate Group Member Organization (GMO). The GM year begins December 1 and ends November 30. A GM allows the member to compete at USEF licensed/USDF-recognized competitions and participate in the USDF Rider Awards program.

Business Membership (BM): A membership that runs December 1 through November 30 and is issued to a business or organization directly by USDF. The USDF BM (\$240) offers a wider variety of advertising benefits. BMs satisfy requirements of horse ownership only.

Non-Member (NM) Identification Number: For each USDF NM owner/lessee and USDF NM rider there will be a USDF NM fee of \$35 per competition that must be collected by the show secretary and submitted to USDF, along with the USDF Report of Fees document and the \$5 affidavit fee and Competition Affidavit Form if the person cannot provide a copy of their USDF NM card. Owners/lessees or riders exempt from the NM number requirements are also exempt from paying the USDF NM fee. If there are multiple owners of a horse and all are NMs, only one of the owners must pay the NM fee. If the horse has at least one owner who is a current USDF PM, GM, or BM there is no NM fee assessed. Competition management will be invoiced for all applicable USDF NM fees not received with the USDF post-competition paperwork, along with a report listing all USDF NMs. Competition management is then required to submit the NM fees within 30 days to the USDF. An individual with a USDF NM identification number is not eligible for any USDF membership benefits. Once a USDF NM number has been assigned, a USDF NM card can be obtained from the USDF website.

Horse Identification (HID) Number: A one-time tracking number for horses (\$35). Scores earned by a horse with an HID number will be recorded, but will NOT be counted towards Adequan[®]/USDF Year-End Awards. A horse with an HID

number is not eligible to compete in Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional qualifying or championship classes. An HID number can be upgraded to a Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR) for a fee of \$80. If a horse has a USDF LHR it does not need an HID number. An HID number is a one-time fee that does not need to be renewed.

Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR): A horse with an LHR (\$115) is eligible for Adequan[®]/USDF Year-End Awards, and eligible to compete in Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional qualifying and championship classes, assuming requirements for the owner and rider are met. If a horse has an LHR it does not need an HID number. An LHR does not need to be renewed.

USDF Statement on Animal Welfare

The United States Dressage Federation, Inc. (USDF), a federation of over 100 independent organizations throughout the United States with a membership of nearly 30,000 members, supports the concept of ethical treatment of animals.

Dressage is a classical method of training horses, based upon the horse's natural responses, as carried out in a gradual, planned program during which the horse's athletic abilities are improved in a systematic manner. As a result, the horse becomes capable, comfortable, and responsive in partnership with the rider without the use of force. Dressage competition at various levels of achievement is the ultimate test of the training program to determine whether the desired harmony between horse and rider has been achieved.

The rules pertaining to dressage competition prohibit the use of artificial appliances, training aids, and drugs, which would force the horse to submit. Instead, the emphasis is upon training and a cooperative partnership with the rider. Major competitions are carefully monitored to assure that there is no unnecessary force or harshness displayed.

Unlike other horse sports in which horses enter training at a relatively immature state, dressage training is usually not seriously begun until the horse is three or four. The top levels of achievement require five or more years of progressive training and it is not unusual to see horses in international competition in their late teens. This, in itself, places a premium on good care and soundness throughout the horse's life.

While supporting the concept of animal welfare in its broadest form, the United States Dressage Federation, Inc., also recognizes that it is unrealistic to ascribe human emotions and responses to the horse which in its wild state is a creature of flight, living a hard and precarious existence. Under domestication, the horse is assured of ample food, water, and shelter, as well as protection against infectious diseases and damaging parasites, thus leading a longer and healthier life with a high rate of survival.

As an educational organization, USDF has numerous programs, which teach people how to pursue the accepted, humane training methods. A program of certifying instructors also emphasizes protecting the horse's welfare in pursuit of dressage training.

A Single Event Membership Fee of \$35 PER PERSON may be paid if not a current member of AHA. You may join the Comstock Arabian Association/AHA at this show. AHA MEMBERSHIP IS REQUIRED except for Lead line, Walk-Trot/Jog and Academy riders.

<u>ADDING CLASSES</u> – For the Friday Sport Horse classes, classes may be added to a horse's or rider's entries between 2 p.m. and 5:30 p.m. Thursday afternoon. For the Saturday morning session, classes may be added to a horse's or rider's entries Friday afternoon up to 1/2 hour after the last class of the day. For the Sunday morning session, classes may be added to a horse's or rider's entries Saturday afternoon up to 1/2 hour after the last class of the day. For the day. For Afternoon sessions, classes may be added to a horse's or rider's entries saturday afternoon up to 1/2 hour after the last class of the day. For Afternoon sessions, classes may be added to a horse's or rider's entries entries until 10:00 a.m. that day. NO POST ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED ONCE THE SESSION HAS STARTED.

<u>ADMISSION TO ARENA</u> – No person will be permitted to enter the arena except participants in the class, judges and their assistants and show officials. Attendants and grooms may enter the arena only when summoned by order of the judge. In all cases w h i c h require grooms or other assistants, PROPER ATTIRE IS REQUIRED.

<u>AGE OF HORSES</u> – For horse show purposes, any horse shall be considered to be one year old on the first day of January following the actual date of foaling. Show Champions and Show Reserve Champions shall be at least two years old, except yearling Arabian and Half/Anglo Arabian geldings may compete for Champion Gelding. A JUNIOR horse is one that is 5 years old and under.

AGE OF RIDER – Age of rider is determined as of December 1, 2019.

<u>AMATEUR OWNER FAMILY DEFINITION</u> – Please see USEF GR123, GR140, and AR110.4.a-f. Horses entered in AMATEUR OWNER and JUNIOR OWNER classes must be registered in the name of competitor or member of competitor's family. Leased horses not eligible. ¬*TWO DISTINCT NON FAMILY OWNERS MAY CO-OWN AND SHOW A HORSE IN JOTR or AOTR classes except that no family member or a professional may enter into this relationship. Both co-owners of horse must have current USEF Amateur membership. No Farm or Corporation co-owned horses are eligible (see USEF AR110 4e).

<u>CONDITION OF ENTRIES</u> – All entries, except entries in equitation and showmanship classes must be serviceably sound. All entries must be in good condition. Horses with loss of sight in one eye may compete in performance classes only. Horses must wear long, natural, unbraided mane (with or without clipped bridle path), and a natural, unset, ungingered tail. The use of glitter on or in the mane, tail, hair or hooves is prohibited. Only clear hoof polish may be used on Breeding and In-Hand horses. Horses must be shown without artificial appliances (AR106.10). Anything that alters the intended use of equipment as provided for in the description of appointments for a given class is considered to be an artificial appliance. This includes but is not limited to tongue ties and/or mouth ties. Gag bits are prohibited (exception: Jumper classes). Action produced by artificial methods shall be penalized. The use of chains, rollers or similar devices on the show grounds during or before a show is prohibited and the show committee shall bar violators from further participation for the remainder of the show, and they shall forfeit all entry fees and winnings for the entire show. (AR106) <u>CRUELTY AND ABUSE</u> – USEF GR839, AHA ARTICLE 304.6 WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED AT ALL COMSTOCK ARABIAN ASSOCIATION/USEF/AHA RECOGNIZED COMPETITIONS.

<u>DISCIPLINE</u> – Exhibitors are warned that any act of discourtesy to the officials of this show on the part of the owner, lessee, trainer, groom, rider, handler or driver will disqualify the horse from adjudication. The management reserves the right to remove a horse, owner, lessee, trainer, groom, rider, handler or driver from the show without being liable for compensation or damages. Excessive use of the whip on any horse in a stall, runway, schooling area or arena or anywhere on the show grounds will result in disqualification of the horse. <u>DISQUALIFICATION</u> – Any horse doctored in any way, artificially, improperly or unfairly prepared or tampered with before entering the show arena will be disqualified. If it is ascertained that any exhibitor has made or caused to be made, any false statement in regard

to any animal or article exhibited, or if any exhibitor shall attempt to interfere with the judges in the performance of their duties, he/she shall be excluded from competing or exhibiting. In case any animal is disqualified, the winner of the next succeeding prize in the class shall take the prize that has been awarded to such disqualified animal and the lowest moneyed prize in the class shall go to the reserve number (USEF GR117)

DOGS – Dogs may be brought to the Show grounds but must be on a leash at all times.

DRESSAGE – All classes shall be conducted according to USEF/EC rules. Only current tests approved by USEF, FEI, USDF, and/or EC shall be used.

DRUG & USEF FEE – Every horse participating in an USEF recognized show must pay a \$23 DRUG/USEF fee PER HORSE. \$15 is to provide funds for research, inspection and enforcement of rules regarding use of medication and drugs and \$8 goes to USEF for administrative services. Horses at a recognized competition are subject to examination that may include physical, urine, blood tests or any other test or procedure at the discretion of the official drug-testing agent. No horse can be shown at an USEF recognized competition if it has been administered in any manner any forbidden substance except as provided in USEF GR410-412. EXHIBITORS, OWNERS, TRAINERS, AND VETERINARIANS ARE CAUTIONED AGAINST THE USE OF MEDICINAL PREPARATIONS, TONICS, PASTES, & PRODUCTS OF ANY KIND, THE INGREDIENTS AND QUANTITATIVE ANALYSIS OF WHICH ARE NOT SPECIFICALLY KNOWN, AS MANY OF THEM MAY CONTAIN A FORBIDDEN SUBSTANCE. All anabolic steroids are forbidden in the Breeding/In-Hand classes for three year olds and under. The exhibitor is to file a medication Report Form with the Show Steward or Designated Show Office Representative within one hour after administration or one hour after the Steward or Designated Show Office Representative returns to duty if administration is at a time other than during competition hours. Lead line, Walk-Trot/Jog and Academy horses are NOT

exempt from the Drugs and Medication rule Equine Vaccination Rule - 1. At Federation licensed competitions horses, more than 7 months of age, entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the stables. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the competition grounds upon request by Competition Management. Documentation should consist of one of the following methods mentioned below. The frequency of vaccine administration should be per the vaccine manufacturers' or veterinarian's recommendations. It is recommended that vaccines are administered by or under the direction of a veterinarian. 2. In the case of vaccines administered by a veterinarian, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide documentation from the veterinarian on documenting that the horse in question received the vaccinations; name of the vaccines and date of vaccine administration. 3. In the case of vaccines administered by a person other than a veterinarian, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide a receipt of the vaccine purchase which is signed by the owner, or agent with care, custody, and control of the horse; name, serial number and expiration date of the vaccine; and date of vaccine administration. 4. In the case of a horse that is unable to receive either of the vaccinations due to a history of adverse reactions, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide a letter from the veterinarian on official letterhead stating that the horse in question cannot be vaccinated due to medical concerns and a log of temperatures taken twice daily for the seven days prior to entering the competition grounds. These horses must also have their temperature taken and logged twice daily while on the competition grounds. The log of temperatures should be provided to the Competition Management, steward, or technical delegate when requested. 5. Competition Management may not amend or enhance vaccination requirements without prior approval of the Veterinary Committee. USEF GR845

<u>FARRIER</u> – The farrier will be on call during show hours on Friday. The farrier will be on the grounds on Saturday and Sunday.

<u>FACE MASKS</u> - Masks or face coverings will be required throughout the facility. The only exception will be that no face masks are required by mounted riders. In-Hand Class Procedures - face masks or face coverings that fully cover your nose and mouth are required at all times at USEF-licensed competitions, including while exhibiting horses and ponies in-hand. However, if absolutely necessary, you may lower your mask while jogging or running with a horse or pony in-hand, or while executing a pattern, but only if you are able to maintain social distancing of at least six feet while doing so. The mask must be replaced immediately once the jog, or run, or pattern, is completed.**A participant cannot be disqualified or penalized for wearing a facemask or face covering while competing. Masks will not be provided to all individuals. tp

FOOD SERVICE - No food service will be available. Exhibitors and crew may bring food and drink onto the RSLEC grounds.

<u>GATE RULE</u> – Exhibitors are cautioned against entering the same horse in successive classes. The TWO-MINUTE call for a class will be enforced. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be sure that his/her horse is at the gate on time. Class calls must be considered a courtesy only. No protests will be upheld on the basis of a public address system malfunction. Gate holds and tack changes are approved ONLY when requested at least 3 classes before the hold.

<u>HALF-ARABIAN/ANGLO-ARABIAN COLTS/STALLIONS</u> – Half-Arabian and Anglo-Arabian stallions registered with AHA or which have been issued an AHA CPAR (Canadian Partbred Arabian Register) Permit are permitted to compete in the AHA performance classes for Half-Arabian and Anglo-Arabian horses. Half-Arabian colts & stallions, two years & older, are excluded from all Breeding/In-Hand halter. Half Arabian and Anglo-Arabian colts/stallions may compete in weanling and yearling Breeding/In-Hand classes for geldings.

<u>HEADGEAR/PROTECTIVE VEST</u>– Juniors riding in Hunter Seat Equitation sections must wear properly fitting protective headgear while riding in the designated schooling & exercise areas and in the show arena. Harness must be secured and properly fitted. All exhibitors entered in English Trail class(es) must wear properly fitting protective headgear while riding in the designated schooling & exercise areas and in the show arena. Any rider violating this rule must immediately be prohibited from further riding until such headgear is properly in place. Any exhibitor may wear protective headgear (ASTM/SEI) and/or a protective safety vest, specifically designed for use in equestrian sports, in any division or class without penalty from the judge. The Federation recommends that the vest meet or surpass the current ASTM/SEI standard. (Please see USEF GR801; DR120.6; EQ105; and AR111).

<u>IDENTIFICATION NUMBERS</u> – Every horse entered in the show will be assigned an identification number. It is important for the proper handling of the show that riders, drivers and handlers wear the correct number in all classes.

INDEMNITY AND NO-RESPONSIBILITY CLAUSES – All entries are accepted with the understanding that the COMSTOCK ARABIAN

ASSOCIATION SPRING FIESTA SHOW and the COMSTOCK ARABIAN ASSOCIATION, RENO, ARABIAN HORSE ASSOCIATION AND USEF FEDERATION will not be held responsible for any loss, damage or injury to any horse exhibited or any article of any kind. All horses shall be under the control and direction of the Show Committee but solely at of the risk of the exhibitor, who will be responsible for any loss, damage or injury to any person, animal or property occasioned by him, his agents or employees, or by an animal owned or exhibited by him, and shall indemnify the COMSTOCK ARABIAN ASSOCIATION SPRING FIESTA SHOW and the COMSTOCK ARABIAN ASSOCIATION, RENO, ARABIAN HORSE ASSOCIATION AND USEF FEDERATION against any and all loss, damages and liability thus occasioned, including but not limited to any and all legal costs including attorney fees, which may be incurred as a result thereof. The submitting of an entry from to the Show Secretary shall constitute an acceptance by each person signing of the provisions therein set forth.

<u>JŪDGĒS</u> – If for any reason a judge fails to attend this show or perform his/her duties, the Show Committee reserves the right to substitute a judge for the one who is officially designated in the Prize list. It is a violation of USEF Rules to commit any act or

make remarks during the show that are considered offensive and/or made with the intent to influence or cast aspersions on the judging (see USEF GR702.1.e). No one shall approach a judge with regard to a decision, or at any time unless he first obtains permission from the Show Committee or Steward who shall arrange an appointment with the judge at a proper time and place.

<u>JUDGES AND STEWARDS COMMISSION</u> The AHA Judges and Stewards Commission is responsible for handling written and signed complaints in relation to judges', stewards' and other show officials' conduct when filed by exhibitors, show officials, AHA members or others, and when accompanied by a \$10 filing fee (Res. 5-90). Other comments, compliments, questions or inquiries are encouraged when appropriate (no filing fee required). Write to AHA JUDGES AND STEWARDS COMMISSIONER, P.O. Box 440949 Aurora, CO 80044-0949. Telephone (303) 696-4537, Fax (303) 696-7878.

JUNIOR EXHIBITORS – To be eligible, riders must not have reached their 19th birthday as of December 1 of the current competition year. The age of an individual on December 1 will be maintained throughout the entire competition year. Persons born on December 1 assume the greater age on that date (see USEF GR103 and GR127). Junior exhibitor's name, address and birthdate along with parent's signature must appear in the "Minor Permission" area on the entry form for all juniors exhibiting in this show.

LOCATION OF CLASSES - The management reserves the right to hold classes, or portions of classes, on the grounds in another location or outside the main arena if it is found necessary to do so. Exhibitors will be notified and changes will be posted in the show office. MINORS OPERATION OF A MOTORIZED VEHICLE: - Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

<u>NUMBER OF ENTRIES IN EACH CLASS</u> – Any class with fewer than three entries after close of entries may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be combined with another class or canceled and the exhibitors in the class(es) will be notified accordingly. Classes will be split at the discretion of the show management. Large classes may be divided and conducted as two separate classes with duplicate prizes and awards, except Championship Performance Classes.

ORDER OF GO Trail/Reining/Horsemanship, Etc. Order of Go will be drawn by horse name by the show office staff and will work in consecutive order.

<u>PROTESTS</u> - -Should any questions or disputes arise, they must be protested in the manner prescribed by USEF GR603. A protest must be in writing and received by the steward, member of the Show Committee, Competition Manager or Show Secretary within 48 hours of the alleged violation, accompanied with a deposit of \$200, if made by an USEF member or parent of a junior exhibitor member or \$300 if made by a non-member.

QUALIFICATIONS FOR REGIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES – The points/scores listed on the National Class List for Regional classes must be obtained in the same AHA Section listed in the AHA Standard Class List. See AHA Handbook Competition Section 1225 for Regional qualifications.

<u>RECREATIONAL VEHICLE/OVERNIGHT PARKING</u> – Full service water, electric and sewer hook-ups are available. Please call the Reno-Sparks Livestock Events Center office to reserve a spot at (775) 688-5752. RV parking is located in the East Parking Lot near the barns. Full service dump station is located by Gate #5 on the south end of the East parking lot. RV Parking permit must be displayed on vehicle.

<u>REFUNDS AND CANCELLATIONS</u> – To encourage early entries, the Management agrees to cancel and refund entry fees on any horse not fit to show providing written notice is given to the Show secretary on or before entry closing date of April 16, 2021. Horses may be scratched from the show at the owner's option. Refunds will be considered from any horse suffering from illness or injury upon the presentation of veterinarian's certificate to the Show Secretary PRIOR to the start of said show. Request of any refund due to the illness or injury of the exhibitor will be considered and will be subject to the Management's decision. ALL REQUESTS MUST BE IN WRITING, ACCOMPANIED BY VETERINARIAN'S CERTIFICATE OR DOCTOR'S LETTER AND MUST BE RECEIVED BY THE SHOW

SECRETARY PRIOR TO THE START OF THE SHOW. On approved refunds, only class fees will be refunded. No refunds will be made on drug fees or office fees. No refunds will be considered for requests received after the start of the show. Substitution of horses will be permitted in accordance with GR912.

<u>REFUSAL OF ENTRY</u> – The management reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries of any exhibitor, as stated in USEF GR914.

<u>REGISTRATION PAPERS REQUIRED</u> – A copy of the F<u>RONT & BACK of</u> the current registration papers showing proof of ownership MUST be submitted with the entry form at the time of making an entry. The copies will be returned in your show packet.

Horses entered in an Amateur Owner or Junior Owner class MUST be registered in the name of the competitor or a member of the Competitor's family. Horses registered in a farm/partnership/corporation name may be shown in Amateur Owner classes provided the family is the sole owner of the farm or entity as defined by USEF GR123. The sale of a horse does not eliminate this registration requirement. Contract of Sale or Bill of Sale will NOT be accepted.

REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS

<u>Arabian Horses</u> – Horses shown in this division must have been issued a certificate of registration from the Arabian Horse Registry of America, Inc. and/or the Canadian Arabian Horse Registry, or if under one year of age, be eligible for registry and registration applied for and must be entered under their full registered name. (Only weanlings that have had registration applied for may show without registration papers).

Half Arabian Horses – Horses shown in this division must have been issued a certificate of registration from the Arabian Horse Association in the Half- Arabian or Anglo-Arabian Registry, or have been issued an Arabian Horse Association (Canadian Partbred Arabian Register) CPAR PERMIT, or if under one year of age, be eligible for registry and registration applied for and must be entered under their full registered name.

<u>RESOLUTION 9-90 FEE</u> – A Judges and Stewards Educational Fee of \$7.00 per horse entered will be charged at all AHA Recognized Shows (AHA 1110.4).

<u>RULES</u> – This Horse Show is conducted in accordance with the rules of the United States Equestrian Federation, Chapter AR, Arabian, Half Arabian & Anglo Arabian Division. The Official Rule Book of USEF will prevail for this show. This Prize List is based on rules of the current Rule Book; any changes or corrections of rules will automatically become a part of the Prize List. Each participant in this show is responsible for the knowledge of and is subject to the USEF Rules. Every class offered herein which is covered by the Rules & Specifications of the current USEF Rule Book will be conducted & judged in accordance therewith. Questions that are not addressed by USEF Rules shall be decided by the Show Committee and their decision is final.

<u>SAFE SPORT TRAINING –</u> All Owners, Trainers, and Handler/Riders must complete the USEF SafeSport Training online prior to entering in this show. Proof of completion must be provided with completed entry. You may go to <u>www.usef.org</u> for more information.

<u>SCRATCHING OR CANCELLING CLASSES</u> – Exhibitors are requested to complete an "Add/Delete Class" form in the show office when it is necessary to scratch or cancel an entered class. The gate person may not take cancellation information. Please see the show secretary prior to the beginning of the scratched/cancelled class.

<u>SHARPS CONTAINERS</u> – Competition Management shall place sharps containers for the disposal of needles and other disposable sharp instruments in convenient locations in barns housing competition horses. It is the Competition Management's responsibility to dispose of them properly. Competition Management may fine any individuals including trainers, owners, exhibitors, or their agents up to \$100 for improper disposal of needles or other sharp disposable instruments. (USEF GR1210.4)

SHOEING REGULATIONS - Refer to current USEF Rule AR103 for Arabian shoeing regulations.

<u>SHOW OFFICE AND REGISTRATION</u> – Registration at the Show Office by the exhibitor is required. The show office will be open at 1:00 p.m. on Thursday, April 29. On Friday, Saturday and Sunday the office will be open one hour prior to the first class and will remain open until one hour after the completion of the show each day. The Show Office will be located inside the Main Arena.

<u>SHOW OFFICE FEE</u> – The show office fee is \$15 per horse.

<u>SHOW OFFICE TELEPHONE</u> – There is no telephone at the show office; however, the Show Manager's cell phone number is (775) 560-0612.

SHOW ARENA CONDITION – The Main Arena footing is dirt. It is approximately 150 feet x 300 feet. The east end of the Main Arena will be used for warm-up on Saturday and Sunday. The outdoor Center/Warm-Up Arena will be available Thursday, Friday, Saturday, and Sunday.

<u>SHOWING FROM TRAILERS</u> - Exhibitors MAY show from their trailers and must park in designated parking areas. The trailerin/grounds fee is \$15.00 PER HORSE PER DAY. Every horse entered in the show MUST pay a stall fee or trailer-in/grounds fee.

Horse trailers must be parked in designated parking areas. Unload and load quickly. Please move your vehicle to designated parking area as soon as possible. Absolutely no vehicles will be allowed in the barn aisles, including the side or front of the barns during the show. Show management will strictly enforce.

<u>SIGNATURES REQUIRED</u> – Every Owner, Trainer, Coach, Rider, Driver and Handler must sign the entry form and provide all requested addresses and telephone numbers. If the Owner has no Trainer, the Owner must sign in Trainer sections.

<u>SINGLE JUDGE SYSTEM</u> will be used in all classes. Each show (Spring Fiesta Show A – Region 3/Spring Fiesta Show B – Region 4) will have one judge adjudicating the show; that is, Judge Melissa Creswick will judge the Dressage Horse and Sport Horse Divisions, <u>Judge</u> Skylar Powell will judge the Spring Fiesta Show A – Region 3 on Saturday and Sunday, and Judge Tamara Burkman will judge the Spring Fiesta Show B – Region 4 on Saturday and Sunday.

<u>STALLIONS</u> – Arabian stallions may be shown by ladies and junior exhibitors in any class in this show except Showmanship, Walk-Trot/Jog, Lead line and Academy classes. Unruly horses in any class will be promptly dismissed.

<u>STALLS</u> – The stall fee is \$115 per stall for the duration of the show for stalls assigned to **Barn 1**. Each stall is 10 feet by 10 feet with a top door and bottom door and has a packed dirt floor. A limited number of stalls are available in **Barns 7**, 8 and 9 for \$125 per stall for the duration of the show. Each stall is 10 feet by 12 feet with a top door and bottom door and has a matted floor. Stalls will be assigned in Barns 7, 8 and 9 on a 'first come first served' request system. Facility requires that stalls with horses be bedded with shavings. Shavings will not be provided by show management; shavings will be available for purchase from the show-contracted vendor. Shavings may be ordered prior to exhibitor's arrival on the show ground. The Show Barn Manager will deliver the shavings upon exhibitor's arrival at Reno- Sparks Livestock Events Center. Please call Show Manager Linda Zimmerman to order your shavings. Call Linda at 775 560-0612. It is **highly** recommended that you order your shavings **prior** to arrival at the show grounds in order to expedite your check-in to your stalls. Shavings will also be available for purchase from Show Barn Manager Kirk Muller on the show grounds. Kirk Muller's phone number during the show for assistance with your stalls or for a request for shavings is 775 450-4091. **IMPORTANT – Exhibitors may be charged for any damage to the stalls or other facilities. Absolutely NO nails are allowed in permanent stalls or stall doors. Do not use contact cement or any other permanent adhesive to attach stall signs or drapes to the barns. Do not tie horses to water or electrical pipes. Any exhibitor found in violation will be charged accordingly for repair. Stalls will be available at 12:00 p.m. on Thursday, April 29, 2021.

TBA (TO BE ANNOUNCED) CLASSES There will be FOUR TBA SLOTS offered on a first come, first served basis. Any class on the AHA class list or that is recognized by AHA can be considered for a TBA class with the exception of Dressage and Sport Horse. To activate a TBA class, an exhibitor must: 1) NAME THE CLASS 2) ENTER CLASS BY PAYING TOTAL CLASS ENTRY FEE (CLASS FEE PLUS SPONSOR FEE) Regular Class Entry Fee \$30 and Sponsor Fee \$ 50 = \$80 Total. Championship Class Entry Fee \$40 and Sponsor Fee \$100 = \$140 Total. Once the class has been activated, exhibitors will be notified via email if time allows. A complete list of TBA added classes will be posted in the horse show office. At that time, all exhibitors will have the opportunity to enter the activated class at TBA class fee (no additional penalty). If TBA added class is a Sweepstakes allocated class, be advised that the Class will not receive Sweepstakes payout.

<u>USEF AMATEUR CERTIFICATION</u> – Include copies of ALL owner's, trainer's, rider's and Breeding/In-Hand handler's current USEF membership cards. **Only active USEF members may obtain amateur status.** Every person who has reached his/her 18th birthday and **completes in classes for amateurs under Federation rules must possess current amateur status** issued by the Federation. Exhibitors are required to have Amateur Certification when competing in classes restricted to Amateurs. Any person who has not reached his/her 18th birthday is an amateur and does not require amateur status. (USEF GR1307)

VETERINARIAN – A licensed veterinarian from Comstock Equine Hospital will be ON CALL from noon until 5:00 Thursday, April 29, 7 A.M. to 5 P.M. Friday, April 30, Saturday, May 1 and Sunday, May 2, 2021. The telephone number (775) 849-0120 will be posted in the office and in the barn. All animals are subject to physical inspection by the show veterinarian at the discretion of the Show Committee. The Show Management reserves the right to refuse entry onto the show grounds to any horse exposed to, or which may be harboring a communicable disease.
