PAYMENT

- You can enter your credit card information on-line. Your card will be charged after your entry has been processed and confirmed. A 3% convenience fee (minimum \$5) will be added to all credit cards.
- You may pay by bank check or money order. Make checks payable in US Funds to COMSTOCK ARABIAN ASSOCIATION Checks must be postmarked by April 21. In fairness to all exhibitors, open checks are not allowed for the initial entry. If an open check is sent, it will be closed for the amount due at the time the entry is processed and will be deposited. Postdated checks will not be accepted. Secretary reserves the right to finalize open checks.
- At the show all exhibitors will be required to leave an open check or credit card, separate from their entries at check-in, before show numbers will be released, to cover any fines or penalties incurred at the show.

CANCELLATIONS AND REFUNDS

- To encourage early entries, Management agrees to cancel and refund entry and stall fees on any horse not fit to show providing written notice is given to the Show Secretary on or before the entry closing date of April 21, 2025.
- Refunds will be considered for any horse suffering from illness or injury upon the presentation of a veterinarian's certificate to the Show Secretary PRIOR to 7PM Thursday, May 1, 2025, and will be subject to the Management's decision.
- Refunds will be considered for any exhibitor suffering from illness or injury upon the presentation of a doctor's letter to the Show Secretary PRIOR to 7PM Thursday, May 1, 2025, and will be subject to the Management's decision.
- All other requests for refunds will be made in writing and submitted to Management for consideration.
- On approved refunds, such refund will include all fees less a \$50 cancellation fee. Substitution of horses will be permitted in accordance with USEF GR910. Horses may be scratched from a class or the entire show at the exhibitor's option but will not be entitled to a refund.
- As a COURTESY to the Gate person, Announcer and the Show Office exhibitors are requested to notify the gate person & show office when it is necessary to scratch or cancel a class entered. This courtesy will enable the Show to run more efficiently. Thank you so much!

GENERAL INFORMATION & RULES

EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH. EACH PARTICIPANT IS RESPONSIBLE FOR KNOWLEDGE OF AND IS SUBJECT TO THE USEF RULE BOOK. THE USEF RULE BOOK IS AVAILABLE AT WWW.USEF.ORG THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE WILL DECIDE QUESTIONS NOT COVERED BY USEF RULES AND ITS DECISIONS WILL BE FINAL.

ACADEMY HORSE Horse must be a regularly used schooling horse. Trainer/Instructor must sign affidavit verifying this. Any breed horse or pony is eligible. USEF/AHA membership requirements do not apply. Entries should be made on the separate Academy Class entry form. School horses may cross enter regular show classes at the same show. Academy classes do not count for CAA Awards.

ADDING CLASSES aka "Post Entry" • Classes must be entered no later than the session prior. Horses that have been previously entered will not be subject to a post-entry fee for classes added after the entry deadline.

AGE OF HORSES AND RIDER • For horse show purposes any horse will be considered to be 1 year old on the first day of January following the actual foaling date. Horses entered in Dressage classes must be 36 months old. Junior exhibitors are those who have not reached their 19th birthday by 12/1/2024. Junior exhibitors are considered amateurs and do not need amateur certification. **Please include birthdates for Adult Amateur; Junior, Leadline and Walk/Trot riders** This information will be used for SPLITTING classes if necessary and determining eligibility.

AHA MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT • **EACH COMPETITOR (THIS INCLUDES AT LEAST ONE RECORDED OWNER AND ALL TRAINERS, DRIVERS, RIDERS, HALTER HANDLERS, COACHES AND THE PERSON(S) SIGNING THE ENTRY BLANK) IN AN ARABIAN HORSE ASSOCIATION RECOGNIZED ARABIAN DIVISION, AT THE TIME OF ENTRY INTO A COMPETITION, MUST SUBMIT A COPY OF A VALID AHA MEMBERSHIP/COMPETITION CARD, JOIN AHA OR PAY AN AHA SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP FEE PER COMPETITOR. WHEN AN AGENT SIGNS FOR THE OWNER AT AN AHA RECOGNIZED COMPETITION, BOTH THE OWNER AND AGENT MUST BE MEMBERS OF AHA OR PAY THE AHA SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP. SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP IS NOT ACCEPTABLE AT AHA REGIONAL OR NATIONAL COMPETITIONS. EXHIBITORS IN WALK-TROT CLASSES ARE EXEMPT FROM AHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS AT QUALIFYING COMPETITIONS, BUT MUST HAVE AN AHA MEMBERSHIP WITH COMPETITION CARD AT AHA REGIONAL AND NATIONAL COMPETITIONS. EXHIBITORS IN LEAD LINE CLASSES OR PARENTS/GUARDIANS SIGNING FOR MINORS ARE EXEMPT FROM AHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS.** (BOD 5/12)

AHA Competition Card Requirements • All riders, drivers, owners, agents and handlers who exhibit horses in the show ring or sign the entry form as the responsible party for any individual's horses at the show must be AHA **competition** level members with competition cards. ***If the recorded owner is an entity (Farm, Ranch, Syndicate, etc.) it must have a current AHA Business membership.***

AMATEUR CERTIFICATION • **THIS IS NOT A USEF APPROVED SHOW, HOWEVER AMATEUR CERTIFICATION IS REQUIRED FOR ADULTS TO SHOW IN AMATEUR RESTRICTED CLASSES. Only active USEF members may obtain amateur certification.** Every person who has reached his/her 19th birthday and competes in classes for amateurs under Federation rules must possess current amateur certification issued by the Federation. Only active Federation members may obtain amateur certification, Amateur cards are no longer available for non-members. Any person who has not reached his/her 19th birthday is an amateur and does not require amateur certification. An amateur continues to be such until he/she has received a change in status from the Federation. There is no fee for amateur certification for Senior Active or Life Members. Refer to GR1306 & GR1307. **Any Active Equine Canada member who is not a current USEF member** and wants to compete in an amateur class must fill out the USEF membership application with their name, signature, date of birth and check the "Amateur" box in order to be eligible to compete. They are not required to pay for a USEF membership or a Show Pass fee. Once the application has been processed, their amateur status will then show up on the USEF website – usef.org and under Search, Membership as "Non-Member Amateur – INACTIVE".

AMATEUR OWNER "FAMILY" /UNRELATED OWNER DEFINITION • Registration papers of horses entered in amateur owner and junior owner classes must in the name of the competitor or a member of the competitor's family or if unrelated owners then the following new rule applies: two nonrelated owners are now able to co-own and show in owner classes IF 1) the ownership is an AND ownership not an OR ownership 2) no family member of a professional may enter into this relationship 3) "non family owners" are defined as two distinct individuals who are not related as family as defined by USEF or EC. 4) the horse must be registered with one of the five Registries in US or Canada or another approved registry. 5) family members of these two co-owners are NOT permitted to show in owner classes. 6) both co-owners must be members of USEF or EC and hold valid amateur cards. 7) co-ownership is limited to two distinct individuals – no farms or business entities. Please see USEF AR110.4.e for complete requirements and limitations. Horses registered in a farm, ranch, syndicate, partnership, or corporation name may be shown in Amateur Owner classes provided the family is the sole owner of the farm or entity as defined by USEF rules.) The sale of a horse does not eliminate this registration requirement. Contracts of Sale or Bill of Sale will not be accepted for owner classes. For ownership by the same family, the term family includes the following: spouse, parent, stepparent, child, stepchild, brother, sister, half brother and sister, aunt, uncle, niece, nephew, step-brother and sister, grandparents and grandchildren, and in-laws of the same relation as stated above. Family also includes a cohabitant, a member of a couple who live together and have an intimate relationship without being married.

ARABIAN REGISTRATION Horses shown in the Arabian division must have been issued a certificate of registration from the Arabian Horse Association Registry and/or the Canadian Arabian Horse Registry or, if under one year of age, be eligible for registry, and registration applied for and must be entered under their full registered name. Half-Arabians and Anglo Arabians must be registered with the AHA Registry in the Half-Arabian and/or the Anglo-Arabian registry or be eligible for registration and registration applied for and must be entered under their full registered name.

ANNOUNCEMENTS • Official updates to this prize list, ride times, TBA/added classes and other announcements will be posted at <https://comstockarabianassociation.com/>. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to secure the most current version of posted show information. Starting the day prior to competition, announcements will be posted at the show office.

AWARDS & RIBBONS • Each judge who officiates will pin the class and present an Award to first, ribbons through fifth place in all halter and performance classes. In Junior Exhibitor Classes there will be an Award to first, ribbons first through eighth. In AHA Medal Classes - Medal to first, ribbons first through eighth. Sagebrush classes will receive awards standard to their normal shows. Management reserves the right to redistribute buckles for any buckle jackpot classes that are not filled.

BREEDING, IN-HAND & PERFORMANCE HALTER CLASSES • will follow the in-ring halter procedure and will be judged using the Arabian Comparative System outlined in the 2023 AHA® Handbook. Performance & Sport Horse In-Hand will use the AHA® Score Sheet.

CHANGES, CANCELLATION OR DIVISION OF CLASSES • Management reserves the right to make changes of arenas, judges, or class order to facilitate time schedule and conditions for betterment of the Show. The Show Committee reserves the right to cancel, combine, or divide any classes or make any scheduling changes necessary. All changes will be posted on the Announcement Board at the office. Any performance championship that reaches 30 entries competing will be shown as a semifinal class with horses selected by the judges for final competition.

CHANGE OF DATE OR CANCELLATION OF SHOW • Show Management reserves the right to change the dates and/or the location of the show or to cancel the show altogether. In the event of a cancellation, all entry fees and stall fees will be refunded. Office fees are non-refundable. Neither the Show Management nor AHA will have any liability to any exhibitor, owner, handler or other person, firm, or corporation by reason of any change or cancellation of the show, except for the return of the aforementioned fees.

CHANGE OF HANDLER OR RIDER • It is the obligation of the exhibitor to notify the show office of any change in rider, driver, handler or cancellation of entry and exhibitors must fill out a handler/rider change form with correct association numbers, documentation, and signatures in the show office **prior to their class**. This also applies to **equestrian horses** changed after entry has been processed. Changes must be submitted before the end of the session before the class is held.

COACH • is defined as an adult who receives remuneration for having or sharing the responsibility for instructing, teaching, schooling, or advising a rider, driver, handler, or vaulter in equestrian skills. That person must sign the entry if coaching on the show grounds.

DISCIPLINE • Exhibitors are advised that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to staff or officials of this show on part of the owner, exhibitor, agent, lessee, trainer, groom, rider, driver, handler, or family of the person participating in the show, will disqualify the horse from adjudication. Management reserves the right to remove a horse or any person from the show without being liable for compensation or damages.

DISPUTES NOT COVERED BY THE RULES • Should any question or dispute arise not provided for in the governing rules of the AHA Handbook and the Value Show Rules, the same will be referred to the Executive Committee whose decision will be final.

GATE RULE/GATE HOLDS • When a gate hold is requested by an exhibitor, such request will be made to the Paddock Master prior to the close of judging of the class immediately before the class requiring the gate hold. The reason for the request should be stated. The gate-hold will be a maximum of three (3) minutes. Appropriate warning will be given to all exhibitors if there is a gate hold in effect. AR 107.1: When horses are competing collectively, if a first horse does not enter the in-gate ready to participate within one minute from when the class is called into the ring, a warning is issued. a. Exhibitors will then have one additional minute to start the steady stream of horses into the in-gate. b. If no horses have entered the gate at the conclusion of the additional one minute, the gate will be closed, and the class is deemed concluded. c. Once the first horse has entered the in-gate, a steady stream of horses must be maintained. d. Should the steady stream be broken after the two minutes have elapsed, the gate will be closed, and judging will commence. e. A steady stream is defined as a constant flow of horses moving forward through the in-gate with a reasonable and safe distance between them (i.e., two to four horse or horse and buggy lengths in between). f. Show Management in conjunction with the Steward may deviate from this procedure as circumstances warrant. GR831.2: A starting order will be established in all classes in which horses compete individually and one minute allowed for an entry to enter the ring.

HEADGEAR • (GR801) Except as may otherwise be mandated by local law, the Federation strongly encourages all riders, while riding anywhere on the competition grounds, to wear protective headgear with harness secured which passes or surpasses ASTM/SEI standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. (Exception hunter, jumper, or hunter/jumper competitions refer to GR801.2) It is the responsibility of the rider, or the parent or guardian or trainer of the junior exhibitor to see to it that the headgear worn complies with appropriate safety standards for protective headgear intended for equestrian use, and is properly fitted and in good condition, and the Federation, Show Committee, Competition Management, and Licensed Officials are not responsible for checking headgear worn for such compliance.

Important information for all Dressage exhibitors: USEF Rule DR120.1.1: Helmets are required for all riders as noted in the following USEF rule From the time horses are officially admitted to the competition grounds by competition management, anyone mounted on a horse at any time on the competition grounds, including non-competing riders, riders on non-competing horses, mounted participants in exhibition classes and those competing in all classes and tests, including Para-Equestrian tests, must wear protective headgear as defined by this rule and otherwise in compliance with GR801. Any rider violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding until such headgear is properly in place.

INCOMPLETE ENTRY FEE • may be assessed on any entry received that is illegible, incomplete, or incorrect. All required information must be clear, easily read, and correct. An entry will be considered incomplete if there are missing registration numbers; missing numbers of AHA, or WDAA memberships for trainers, owners, riders, or handlers; missing signatures; missing or incorrect payment for entries.

LEASED HORSES • may not be shown by the lessee in Amateur Owner To Ride (AOTR) classes. The lessee becomes the bona fide owner of the horse for the period of the lease (except for Owner classes) for Federation award purposes. The horse must be entered in the ownership of the lessee and must be shown in accordance with USEF Chapter 11.

ORDER OF GO • All Breeding/Gelding In-Hand classes will be youngest to oldest, including post entries. All working western, equitation pattern classes and showmanship classes will have a posted order of go. All "orders of go" will be posted on the Announcement Board at the Show Office and given to the Paddock Master not less than one hour prior to the start of that class. Accommodations may be made by the Paddock Master in the case of class conflicts.

POST ENTRIES • will be closed after the last class of the session before the class is held. Horses entered after the closing date will pay a flat Late Entry Fee. Dressage, Western Dressage & In-Hand post entries are limited and only allowed in the event a ride/run time becomes available.

QUALIFICATIONS FOR REGIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS • **The rules for qualification have changed. It is so much easier to get qualified for multiple regions!!** Participation at local shows for Regional classes must be obtained in the same AHA Section listed in the AHA Standard Class List. It's easy to qualify for the 2025 Championship shows. There are different rules that apply depending on the age of the horse and the particular class in which it will be shown. Riders who show in equitation or showmanship have specific rider qualifications that must be met.

RDNE (RODE DID NOT ENTER) • Any entry which shows in a class in which it was not properly entered will be charged the regular class fee plus a \$25.00 RDNE fee. To be properly entered in a class, the class must have been listed on the original entry blank or on a properly submitted Add/Scratch Form in the show office. Telling the paddock master to add an entry to a class does not constitute a proper entry and will result in an RDNE charge. Further, the paddock master is not responsible for keeping an entry out of a class that is not properly entered in it.

REFUNDS • Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that all or part of the competition is cancelled due to a storm, acts of God, illness, accident, or other emergency at the show. Refunds for improperly entered classes only in cases of secretary error.

WDAA MEMBERSHIP • To be eligible to participate and/or compete as an **exhibitor, owner, lessee, agent, coach, or trainer** in any Western Dressage class or at any Western Dressage Federation Licensed Competition persons **must be active members of WDAA** (westerndressageassociation.org) or pay a non-member fee equal to the price of an annual membership for each competition. Lessees are considered owners in connection with this membership requirement. In the event of an entry under multiple ownership, only one owner need be a Member or pay a non-member fee. The competition is responsible for listing either the active member or the owner that paid the non-member fee in the results. The competitions will be responsible for forwarding a list of the names of individuals who pay non-member fees at the competition to WDAA with the post competition report. Payment of non-member fees for the purpose of competing does not entitle the individual to any privileges of the WDAA membership. *Effective 12/1/21.*

REFUSAL OF ENTRIES • Entries may be refused from anyone who has an outstanding obligation to an affiliated club, show or contracted services. Management reserves the right to hold classes conditionally, or cancel entries of any contestant, as stated in USEF Rules. Management reserves the right to remove any horse or person from the show who has shown an objectionable attitude or behavior towards its management, or previous unsportsmanlike behavior, without being liable for compensation or damages.

SAFE SPORT REMINDER: – AHA requires that those 18 years and over be current with Safe Sport training to show at this show, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. More information about these can be found at <https://www.usef.org/safe-sport>. If you experience technical difficulties with the SafeSport Training, please submit [this form](#) (located within your USEF member dashboard). SCORE SHEETS • If a mathematical scoring error on the score sheet is discovered, it must be reported to Show Secretary within one hour of the official posting of the scores from the last scored class of that competition day or the error will stand with no change in class placings. Please claim all Dressage test sheets and In-Hand score sheets at the awards room before you leave the show; they will not be mailed.

STALLIONS • Arabian stallions may be shown by junior exhibitors in any class in this show except Showmanship, Walk- Trot/Jog, Lead line and Academy classes.

TRAINER • USEF defines Trainer as “the adult is responsible for the horse (care and custody) while it is on the show grounds.” The parent or guardian of a minor exhibitor must assume the responsibilities of “Trainer.” Therefore, every horse does have a Trainer, and that person must sign the entry and provide copies of membership cards or pay associated fees. Parents signing as Trainer for minor children are exempt from association fees. *If you keep your horse at home (or board out) and pay for riding lessons, but do not pay for full time training and care, the person you pay for lessons is your “Coach”.*

VETERINARIAN • A licensed veterinarian from Comstock Equine Hospital will be ON CALL from NOON until 5PM Thursday; 7AM to 5PM Friday, Saturday & Sunday. The telephone number (775) 849-0120 will be posted in the office and in the barn. All animals are subject to physical inspection by the show veterinarian at the discretion of the Show Committee. Show Management reserves the right to refuse entry onto the show grounds to any horse exposed to, or which may be harboring a communicable disease.

SAGEBRUSH RULES

Added Classes: To add a class you must do so by entering with the Show Secretary at least 3 classes before the one you want to enter. A late fee may be added if classes are added during the show.

Admission to Ring: No person will be permitted to enter the ring except participants in that class, judges, their assistant and show officials. Attendants and/or grooms or owners may enter the ring when summoned by order of the judge.

All Breed Classes: Any eligible equine may enter classes named "All Breed" in this show. A stallion's handler must be 18 years of age as of January 1 of this year.

Appearance/Grooming: Attire for competitors will be based on what is normal for the local area and for the class being entered with emphasis on neatness and safety. Silver not to count. Competitors must display the correct exhibitor number which should be clearly visible while performing in any class. Riders must wear appropriate standard attire for English or Western, unless judge says otherwise.

Arabian/Half Arabian/Anglo Arabian Classes: Horses must be registered with the Arabian Horse Association. Please provide registration papers with entry.

Awards and Ribbons: No awards, prizes or ribbons will be presented. All classes have Jackpot paybacks and checks will be issued at the end of the four show circuit. High Point and Reserve High Point Awards will be presented for All Breed and Arabian Western and English Horses (Senior Rider and Junior Rider divisions) as well as for Color Breed Horses. High Point and Reserve High Point Awards will be presented to exhibitors that are regularly enrolled 4-H club members. High Point and Reserve High Point Awards will be presented to Exhibitors in All Breed and Arabian Walk/Trot/Jog classes. To qualify for a High Point Award a horse or rider must show in at least two Sagebrush shows during the 2021 circuit.

Condition of Entries: All entries, except entries in Equitation and Showmanship classes must be serviceably sound. All entries must be in good condition. Horses must be shown without artificial appliances (anything that alters the intended use of equipment). This includes but is not limited to tongue ties and/or mouth ties. Tie downs, splint or bell boots or leg wraps (except reining horses may wear performance boots), martingales, training devices are prohibited. Actions produced by artificial methods shall be penalized. Cruelty is prohibited.

Discipline: Exhibitors are warned that any act of discourtesy to the officials of this show on the part of the owner, rider or handler will disqualify the horse from adjudication. The management reserves the right to remove a horse, owner, rider or handler from the show without being liable for compensation or damages. Excessive use of the whip or any other device on any horse in or out of the arena or anywhere on the show grounds (during the day of the event) will result in disqualification of the horse and handler. Any horse doctored in any way, artificially, improperly or unfairly prepared or tampered with before entering the arena will be disqualified. If any exhibitor shall attempt to interfere with the judges in the performance of their duties, he/she shall be excluded from competing or exhibiting. In case any animal is disqualified, the winner of the next succeeding prize in the class shall take the prize that has been awarded to such disqualified animal /rider/handler and the lowest moneyed prize in that class shall go to the reserve number.

Headgear: Riders 17 years & under are encouraged to wear properly fitting ASTM/SEI approved equestrian protective headgear while riding in the designated schooling /exercise areas and the arena grounds. Chin strap must be secured and properly fitted. Any exhibitor may wear protective headgear in any division or class without penalty from the judge. Riders 12 years & under are required to wear properly fitting ASTM/SEI approved equestrian protective headgear.

Walk/Trot/Jog Classes: Walk/Trot/Jog classes: (Except for WARM-UP). Horse/ Rider combination may not enter any class that includes 3 gaits in the class specifications. Walk/Trot/Jog classes are offered for those riders who are not ready to canter or lope in competition. If you have previously shown in three gaited classes in your horse show career, please do not enter these classes designed for beginning or retired or returning-to-the-show-ring riders.

English & Western Pleasure Walk/ Trot/Jog Warm Up: Open to all ages and all breeds. All riders to show in the proper English or Western attire with proper English or Western tack. To be shown at a walk and jog/trot both directions in the arena. Entry into 3-gaited classes okay. These classes do not count toward High Point Awards.

English Discipline: Rider will perform variations of gaits and maneuvers as called by the announcer. Work on the rail may include collected, normal or extended gaits, side pass, turn on the forehand or haunches, counter canter and other safe maneuvers. Judged on precision, willingness, subtlety of cues, ability to perform.

English Riding Skills: This class is offered to determine the riding ability of the rider. All exhibitors will perform a pattern as posted the day of the show. Although the posted pattern will be similar to the Ranch Horse Riding class, English Riding Skills will demonstrate appropriate English/ Country English/Hunt gaits, attitude and tack.

Walk/ Trot/Jog Equitation, Pleasure and Trail Rider 13 & Over, 11 & Over, 12 and Under. 10 & Under: In Equitation, Pleasure, Rock & Roll in the Sagebrush and Trail classes, the All-Breed rider must be twelve years old or younger on January 1st of this year to ride in "12 and Under" classes. In Equitation, Pleasure and Trail classes the Arabian rider must be ten years or younger on January 1st of this year to ride in "10 & Under" classes. Stallions prohibited. Saddle

must fit rider and rider's feet must be engaged in the stirrups or irons for safety. An ASTM/SEI approved equestrian safety helmet must be worn by All Breed 12 and Under rider and Arabian 10 and Under rider. All walk/trot/jog riders can show either English or Western with proper attire and tack. To show at a walk, trot or jog both directions in the arena in Equitation and Pleasure; to negotiate obstacles in Trail. Walk/Trot/Jog classes are offered for those riders who are not ready to canter or lope in competition. If you have previously shown in three-gaited classes in your horse show career, please do not enter these classes designed for beginning riders.

Walk/Trot/Jog Equitation, Pleasure and Trail for Novice 4-H Rider/Cloverbud 4-H Rider: Rider must not have won more than 3 blue ribbons in any equitation, pleasure or trail classes. To show at a walk, trot or jog both direction of the arena; English or Western attire with appropriate tack is required. Horse/rider combination may not enter any class that includes 3 gaits in the class specifications. Cloverbud 4-Hers ages 5 to 8 years old may enter the Novice/Cloverbud classes with a handler 14 & Over. Cloverbud leadliners are not allowed to go in the Warm Up Open classes.

Western Discipline: Rider will perform variations of gaits and maneuvers as called by the announcer. Work on the rail may include collected, normal or extended gaits, side pass, turn on the forehand or haunches, counter canter/lope and other safe maneuvers. Judged on precision, willingness, subtlety of cues, ability to perform.

Western Pleasure: To be shown at a flat-footed four-beat walk, a two-beat jog and a three-beat lope both directions of the arena. To be judged on manners, performance, substance, quality and conformation. Extreme speed to be penalized. Horse and rider must perform smoothly as a team. Must be shown in western attire and western tack. Silver not to count.

Western Riding: Credit shall be given for, and emphasis placed on, smoothness with even cadence of gaits and the horse's ability to change leads precisely and easily rear and front at the center point between markers. The horse should have a relaxed head carriage showing response to the rider's hands with a moderate flexion at the poll. Horses may be ridden with light contact or on a reasonably loose rein. The horse should cross the log at both the jog-trot and lope without breaking gait or radically changing stride.

Western Seat Equitation: Rider will be judged on seat, hands, performance of horse, appointments of horse and rider and suitability of horse to rider. Results as shown by the performance of the horse are not to be considered more important than the method used in obtaining them. All riders enter the arena at a walk or jog and are judged at a flat-footed four-beat walk, a two-beat jog and a three-beat lope both directions of the arena. All competitors are required to back in a straight line during the lineup. Must be shown in western attire and western tack.

Please use the Comstock entry form for signing up for your classes. Please note that if you are only showing in Sagebrush classes you are not required to provide AHA, USEF or WDAA membership numbers. 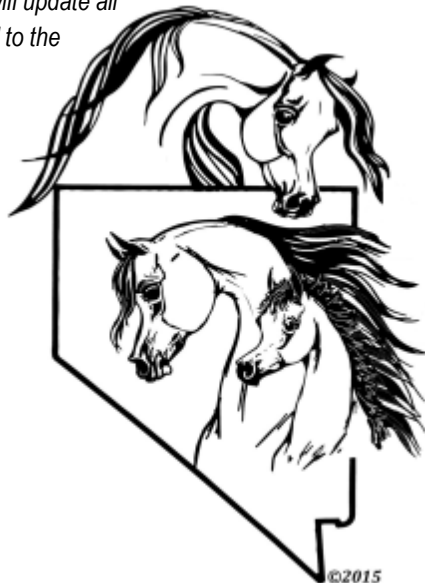

In consideration for AHA permitting me to participate in this Competition, and by signing the entry blank, I agree as follows: I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in this Competition, as a rider, driver, handler, lessee, owner, agent, coach, trainer, junior exhibitor, or as a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. I AM FULLY AWARE AND ACKNOWLEDGE THAT HORSE SPORTS AND PARTICIPATION IN THIS COMPETITION INVOLVE SERIOUS RISK OF HARM INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, RISKS OF ACCIDENT, SERIOUS BODILY INJURY, INCLUDING DEATH, BROKEN BONES, HEAD INJURIES, TRAUMA, PAIN, AND SUFFERING, AND PROPERTY DAMAGE. I ASSUME ALL RISKS OF HARM TO ME, MY HORSE OR MY PROPERTY.

I AGREE as a Horse Show Participant (or Parent/Guardian of Participant if a minor) to waive all claims which may otherwise arise from, including but not limited to infectious bacteria, viruses, fungi/mold, parasites or other agents which may be present at the Horse Show (and most other outdoor locations) and can cause infection in humans, as well as in animals.
